

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (BSIT)

- The internship program is **MANDATORY in order to graduate**
- Students must complete **at least 90 credits** (12 credits at FDU for transfer students) to be eligible for the internship program
- Students must plan to complete the internship program in the final year (7th/8th term) of their program
 - Students enrolled before Fall 2022 may complete the internship before meeting these requirements with academic approval
- Students must have a minimum CGPA of 2.0
 - Students enrolled before Fall 2022 must have a minimum CGPA of 2.5
- Internships are considered as a part-time job placement (12-25 hours/week) for a total of 150 hours 300 hours
- Students may take other courses concurrently
- The internship course code is INFO 4497 worth 3-credits
 - Students CANNOT complete their internship as part of CAPSTONE (INFO 4205)
- This internship course may only be taken once and may not be repeated

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA)

- The internship program is MANDATORY for those taking a digital marketing minor, it is optional for other minors
- Students must complete at least 48 credits to be eligible
 - Transfer students must complete 12 credits at FDU
- Students must have a minimum CGPA of 2.5 to be eligible
- Internships are considered as a part-time job placement (12-25 hours/week) for a total of 150 hours 300 hours
- The internship course is worth **3-credits**
- Students may take other courses concurrently
- Students may complete one of their required business major electives through the following internship course codes:
 - MKTG 4941 Marketing related internships (mandatory if a student is taking a digital marketing minor - required at least MKTG 2120)
 - o FIN 4941 Finance related internships (required FIN 3250)
 - MGMT 3941 Administrative or operations support/ internships that are not related to the previous two categories (required MGMT 2600)
- Students may only take one or more of each internship, however, may not repeat the same internship course

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN INDIVIDUALIZED STUDIES (BAIS)

- The internship program is **optional** to complete
- The internship program is a replacement for an elective course
 - 3 electives + internship program
- Students must complete at least 48 credits to be eligible
 - Transfer students must complete 12 credits at FDU
- Students must have a minimum CGPA of 2.5 to be eligible
- Internships are considered as a part-time job placement (12-25 hours/week) for a total of 150 hours 300 hours
- The internship course is worth **3-credits**
- Students may take other courses concurrently
- Students may choose to withdraw from the internship program and switch to an elective to complete their 4 elective requirement

MASTERS OF SCIENCE IN APPLIED COMPUTER SCIENCE (MSACS)

- The internship program is optional to complete
- The internship program is a replacement for a specialization course
 - 3 specializations + internship program
- Students must complete ALL of the CORE courses (15 credits) to be eligible (<u>CSCI 6623, 6620, 6638, 6836, 7645</u>)
 - This excludes CAPSTONE (CSCI 6806) and pre-requisite courses
- Internships are considered as a full-time job placement (35-40 hours/week) for a total of 300 hours 400 hours
- Students CANNOT enroll concurrently with any other course during their internship semester(s) (including CAPSTONE)
 - CAPSTONE must be completed BEFORE the internship program or AFTER - in the last semester of their program
- Students have the option to complete the 3-credit internship program over 1-term OR 2-terms:
 - Students who select a 1-term placement will register under course code CSCI 8891 (3 credits)
 - Students who select a 2-term internship placement will register under two 1.5-credit internship course codes: <u>CSCI 8892</u> (1.5 credits) + <u>CSCI 8893</u> (1.5 credits)
- Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 to be eligible
- Students may choose to withdraw from the internship program and switch to a specialization to meet the 4 specialization course requirement



MASTERS ADMINISTRATIVE SCIENCE (MAS)

- The internship program is optional to complete
- The internship may be taken BEFORE or DURING the last term of their program
- Internships are considered as a full-time job placement (35-40 hours/week) for a total of 300 hours 400 hours
- Students need to complete a minimum of 15 credits of their core program to be eligible (MADS 6600, 6601, 6602, 6604, 6610)
- The internship course is considered an **additional 1-credit** to the required number of credits for their program to graduate
 - Students are required to pay tuition for this additional credit
 - Students are eligible for a full tuition refund if they choose to withdraw before the stated deadline
- The internship course code is MADS 5000
- The internship course can be completed BEFORE or CONCURRENTLY with CAPSTONE (MADS 6612)
 - If students have chosen to complete both their internship concurrently with CAPSTONE, it must be during the last semester of their program
 - The internship program CANNOT be completed concurrently with other courses (excluding CAPSTONE)
